Illinois Livestock Sector

- The livestock sector generates \$3.5 billion dollars annually.
- Illinois currently has 30,094 livestock farms.
- In 2011, Illinois exported 12% of its output from all livestock sectors to other states
- Generates \$292 million in taxes
 - ✓ \$138 million were paid to the state and local levels
- Livestock production only meets 40% of Illinois' demand
- Supports 25,385 jobs
- About 35% of the gross receipts for the state are from livestock.

Tax Flows from the Illinois Livestock Industry to State and Local Transportation Budgets

Total Direct Economic Output of the Illinois Livestock Industry \$3.5 Billion
Total Taxes Paid by the Illinois Livestock Industry \$292 Million (15%)
Total State and Local Taxes Paid by the Illinois Livestock Industry \$138 Million (47%)
Total Indirect Business Taxes* Paid by the Illinois Livestock Industry \$105 Million (73%)
Total State and Local Taxes Paid for Transportation by the Illinois Livestock Industry \$7.9 Million (7.8%)
Total State Taxes Paid for Transportation by the Illinois Livestock Industry \$5.2 Million (5.1%)
Total Local Taxes Paid for Transportation by the Illinois Livestock Industry \$2.7 Million (2.7%)
